



THINGS US BIG KIDS SHOULD KNOW

He sounds really nice, and asks you if you would like to walk up to his car and help him eat the yummy chocolate he has in there.


Would you go to the car with the man?




My Mum told me that some people who offer kids chocolate and lollies can be very scary people just pretending to be nice.

What if that grown up told you that your Mum and Dad wouldn't love you anymore if they found out you let someone touch your privates? Would you believe them?





Here is a tricky question for you.

One day you are playing outside by yourself. Bob walks over to say hello and invites you over to his house to learn some magic tricks. What do you do?






A man walks up to you at the park and tells you he has lost his puppy and needs your help to find him.

He tells you there is not enough time, you have to leave now and offers to buy you an ice-cream as a reward if you find the puppy.


What would you do?
